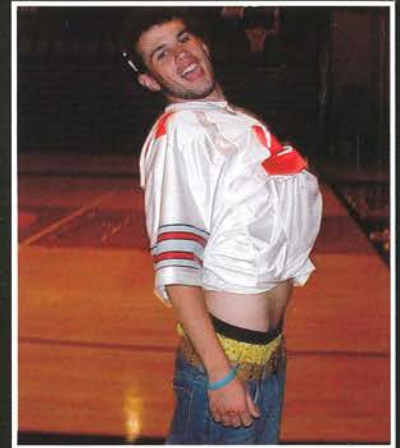

We had even more running success with the cross country team sending Deirdre Clary, Erin Murphy and Patrick Gorby to state.

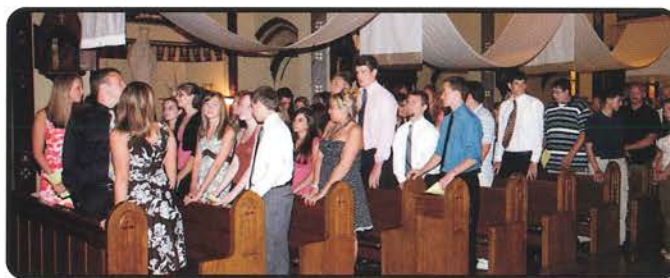

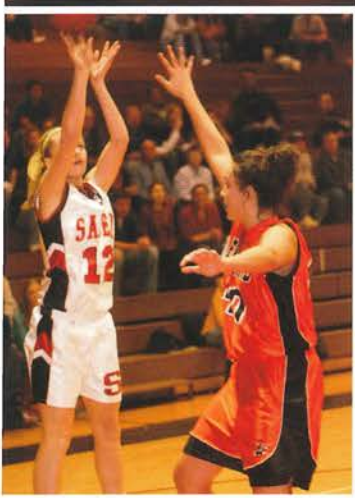

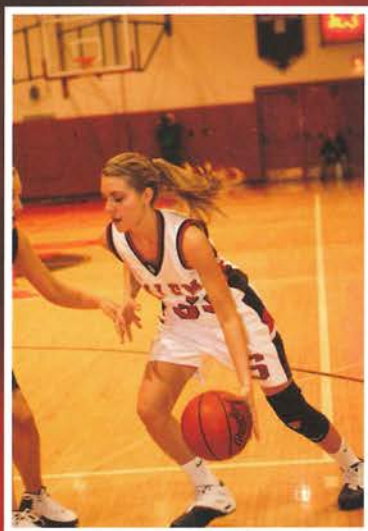

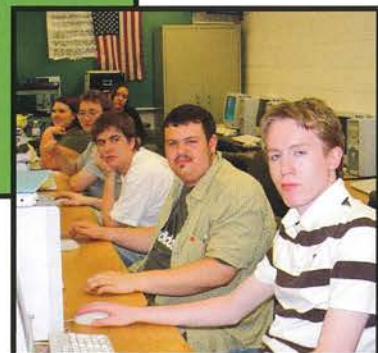

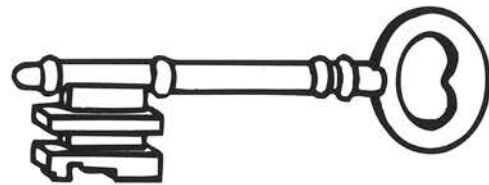
