

Without the employer, this much needed program would fail. Over the years, hundreds of O.W.E. students have been placed in the businesses and industries of Salem. Many of these former students are still employed in the area, and many with their original employer. Some go on to further their education, and become foremen,

supervisors, and managers. The primary reason for their success is the employers who hire and help train them. A commitment from local employers to continue to hire and work with the O.W.E. students will ensure future successes by keeping young people in school while helping them become reliable workers and citizens.

In 2008, 60 scholarships with a total value of \$234,950 were awarded to four alumni and 52 graduating seniors. Four 2008 graduates received two awards. Since 1908, the Salem High School Alumni Association has given \$4,187,562.50 in 1,836 scholarships.


